ISETS-ESCAP Global Competition of Youth Voice on Energy Transition

Evaluation Process

14 September 2024

To ensure fairness, each submission was anonymized and assigned a random number. Submissions were then divided into groups of approximately 15, with each group reviewed anonymously by a different reviewer. Each submission was placed in three distinct groups to minimize any potential bias in evaluations, and reviewers were rotated among the groups to further reduce bias. The final score for each submission was determined by averaging the scores from the three different reviewers across the three groups.

The 15 review panel members were from more than 10 countries. To maintain anonymity, the "Division" column was removed, and team names were replaced with participant numbers (e.g., YC-2024-001) throughout the evaluation process.

The **ISETS-ESCAP Youth Voice on Energy Transition Program** has established detailed assessment criteria to ensure that submissions contribute meaningfully to the global shift to sustainable energy.

Review panel members were asked to recommend up to **five teams** as potential division finalists, serving as a cross-check for the scoring process.

This double-blind system ensured that each submission was evaluated by three different reviewers, with no two reviewers assessing the same set of submissions.
